専門は原子炉物理、臨界安全、研究炉の安全管理、原子力工学の人材育成など。

After completing the Master course at Hokkaido University, he worked at the Japan Atomic Energy Research Institute (now the Japan Atomic Energy Agency) from 1982 to 2003. After that, he was appointed as an associate professor at the Kyoto University Research Reactor Institute (now the Institute for Integrated Radiation and Nuclear Science). Professor since 2007. He served as director of the institute for two years from April 2021 and retired in March 2023. He also served as President of the Atomic Energy Society of Japan from June 2020 to June 2021.

His research interests include reactor physics, criticality safety, safety management of research reactors and human resource development in nuclear engineering.
